Today our topic is: **Christmas "20 Questions Game"**

We will review common vocabulary words related to the Christmas holiday and play the "20 Questions" game.

The 20 Questions Game

How to Play: If you have never played this game, here are the rules:

Preparation:

- Prepare a list of Christmas-related words or phrases (e.g., mistletoe, Santa Claus, gingerbread house, sleigh, Christmas tree, poinsettia, caroling, snowman, reindeer, eggnog).
- Share the rules with the class before starting.

Game Setup:

- One student is the "thinker" and selects a Christmas-related word from the prepared list.
- The rest of the class are the "guessers."

Gameplay:

- The guessers take turns asking **yes/no** questions to figure out the word.

Examples:

- *Is it a decoration?*
- *Do people eat it?*
- *Does it involve music?*

- The thinker can only respond with "Yes," "No," or "I'm not sure."

Rules:

The guessers must figure out the word within **20 questions** or the thinker wins. If the class guesses correctly, they win.

Rotation:

After each round, another student becomes the thinker.
